On March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2005, after a formal request from the East St. Paul Police for assistance, the Professional Standards Unit was assigned to assist them with their investigation into a fatal motor vehicle collision involving a member of the Winnipeg Police Service that occurred on February 25<sup>th</sup>, 2005.

Members of the Professional Standards Unit will be conducting an interview with you regarding any knowledge you may have, on **Wednesday March 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2005 or Thursday March 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2005 (time to be coordinated with your Shift Supervisor)**. The interview will take place in the Professional Standards Unit offices, **tenth floor of the Confederation Building located at 457 Main Street.**

Be advised that you will be interviewed as a **Witness** and in accordance with current Winnipeg Police Service policy, the interview will be audio taped. Anything you say may be used in any criminal, civil, or Winnipeg Police Service proceedings that may arise as a result of this investigation. You are instructed to bring any applicable **original notes** that you have made. You are being notified in advance of the interview to afford you an opportunity to contact the Winnipeg Police Association for advice, if you so desire.

This interview is scheduled to take place while you are on duty. If there is any conflict, such as court or leave, you are to notify the undersigned as soon as possible to reschedule the interview.

The Confederation Building is secure access. Please call the writer at [REDACTED] upon arrival and a member of the unit will come down to meet you.
