- What was the basis for the guilty plea to dangerous driving cause death e.g. inadvertence as opposed to impairment?
- What was the basis for the recommendation of a conditional sentence?
- Is the fact the accused was a member of the Winnipeg Police Service a relevant factor in sentencing?
