I am writing this letter as a follow up to our phone conversation of October 1, 2007.

As you will recall, we discussed, at length, your concern that Mr. Minuk continues to act as Crown counsel in the Harvey-Zenk prosecution and that you think the proceedings should be stopped before an injustice occurs. I confirmed to you that the Law Society simply does not have the jurisdiction to affect or influence court proceedings. While we can investigate the conduct of lawyers and discipline them, where appropriate, we cannot get justice or redress for people affected by court proceedings.

You also asked me to reconsider our decision to hold off our initial assessment of your complaint until Judge Wyant renders his decision on sentencing, as you hoped that the initiation of an investigation might influence the court proceeding. As promised, I discussed the matter further with our Chief Executive Officer and, for the reasons outlined above and in my letter to you of September 25, 2007, he has confirmed that our assessment ought to await Judge Wyant's decision.
