Remarks: Description of findings at scene, attack method, investigation results and all material facts.

Responded to a 3 vehicle accident. 2 cars were stopped at a red light, and the Dodge Dakota pickup rear ended the Sprint, driving the sprint into the Hundi.  
Driver of sprint: Crystal Taman, was declared deceased at the scene. Jaws of life were used to extricate her from the vehicle. ESP Fire cut the roof back and removed her to a back board.  
Hundi Driver: Cathy Beattie suffered bruising and possible spinal injury, and was treated and immobilized to a back board by ESP Medical Responders and Winnipeg Medics.  
Driver of Dakota: Derek Harveymordenzenk was assessed for injuries but did not require transport to Hsp.  
Fire companies saftied all the vehicles with hand tools, and applies sand to fluids and Gas on Hwy 59.  
Scene turned over to police for investigation.
